

Young Science Professionals Scholarship Fund

Guidelines and Application Form

The Young Science Professionals Scholarship Fund was created to provide technical career-minded individuals the opportunity to develop professionally, civically, and socially.

In order to apply for this scholarship, candidate must:

- 1. Be a high school senior who will graduate in Spring of 2024, or full-time undergraduate student currently attending a four-year college, or have been accepted to a four-year college and will begin attending in the Fall of 2024.
- 2. Have a grade point average of 3.0 or better (on a 4.0 scale).
- 3. Have verifiable volunteer experience within the past two years.
- 4. Have membership and/or leadership experience with campus and/or community or professional organizations.
- 5. Complete an application and include a one-page essay explaining how you envision your involvement in the Sciences or Aerospace.

The PSAM Scholarship Fund Committee will select the scholarship recipient (subject to the approval of the PSAM Board of Directors). No member of the Scholarship Fund Committee, or his or her immediate family, shall be eligible for YSPSF scholarship assistance during his or her tenure on the Scholarship Fund Committee. No member of the Board of Directors, or his or her immediate family, shall be eligible for YSPSF scholarship assistance during his or her tenure on Board of Directors.

The PSAM Scholarship Fund Committee retains the right to withhold scholarship grants in any year if no candidate is determined to be qualified. The Organization shall notify the chosen scholarship recipient(s) of its decision in writing. The related scholarship payment will be made following Board of Director approval and after the selected student notifies PSAM in writing the payment registrar and school address they will be attending. All scholarship checks will be made payable to the university for the student.
